The November/December 2011 issue of Claptrap enclosed herewith completes the six issues covered by your 2011 subscription, so it's now time for you to think about renewing for 2012. We very much hope that you will decide to continue as a CLAPA member, and if so a renewal form is printed below.

Rates for UK members remain the same as in 2011 – £20 for Single Members and £30 for Family Groups.

As regards overseas rates, your committee has been aware for some time of the disparity that exists between the UK and Overseas postal rates for sending out Claptrap. Up until now we have been prepared to absorb this extra cost, but a large increase in overseas postal rates earlier in 2011 means that it now costs nearly £1 more *per issue* to post to overseas destinations than it does within the UK. Regrettably therefore your committee has decided that as from the start of 2012 subscriptions for overseas members (which includes Europe and Southern Ireland) must be increased to £26. We hope this short explanation will go some way to giving you an understanding as to why it is has been necessary to make this increase.

If you wish to continue as a member then please complete the form below, attach your cheque for the appropriate amount (made payable to CLAPA) and post it to Andrew Tinsley at the address details on the bottom of this form. To ensure that there is no interruption in the flow of future issues of Claptrap to your home address it would be helpful if you could renew by the end of January 2012.

If we hear nothing further from you then no more issues of Claptrap will be posted out to you and your name will be removed from our membership database.
